After turning, immediately merge into the left lane. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Mill Road. The church/school is approximately three miles on right.

From Macon (south): Take Interstate 75 north out of Macon. Exit the Interstate on Exit 218. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Highway 20. After turning, merge into right lane. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Highway 81. After passing elementary school, watch for Mill Road. Turn right onto Mill Road. The church/school is approximately one mile on left.
